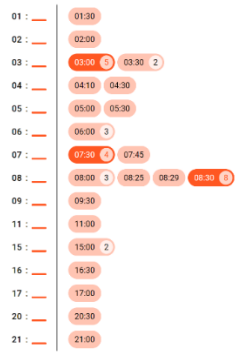


How much time do kids spend on screens?

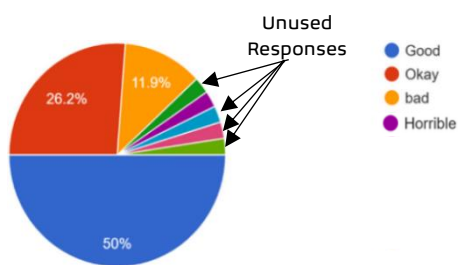


What time do you go on screens?

- What time do they get on screens?

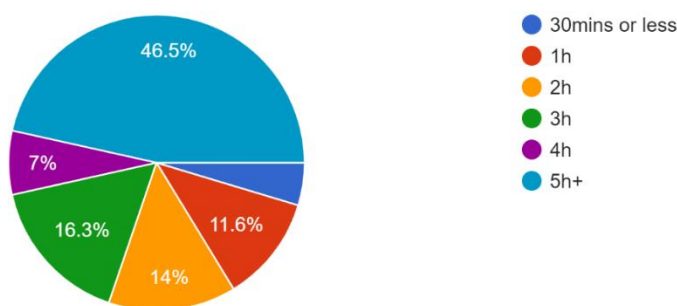
How do you feel of your screen time usage?

 What do you think about the amount of screen time you get?
 What time do you get on screens?

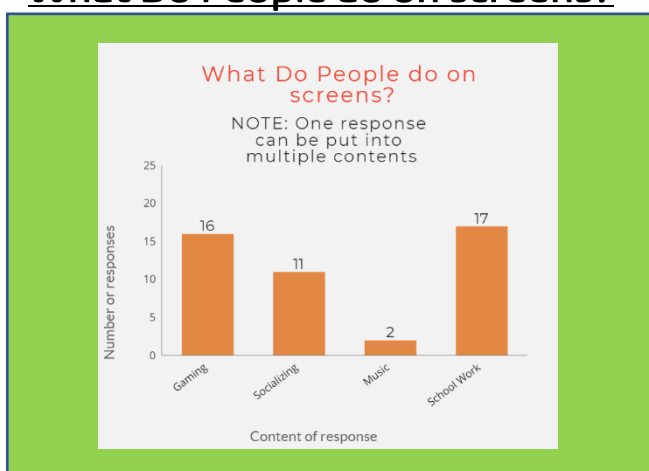
How much time do you spend on screens?



Hypothesis

Our hypothesis is that children spend lots of time on screens since they have grown up with these devices. It is also what most people do in their spare time. Doing homework, playing games, or even chilling on social media are some everyday activities that contribute towards overall screen time.

What Do People do on screens?



Explanation

We think that the data occurred because of the various events going on in the world like home-schooling for New South Wales. The data with the other big trends 3 hours and 2 hours, have occurred to the people who are not doing online school and are doing their usual time that they spend on screens. The mode of the data is 5 hours which makes sense as a lot of countries, schools, states are doing remote learning. The average is 3.51162791 which makes sense as there are a lot of kids who do remote learning, and we mainly posted these forms to our class and in Discord Servers (meant for gamers). With the mode being at 5 hours which we consider high usage, we wanted to see how people felt about it. Exactly 50% of all the survey answers said that they felt good about their screen time usage. Out of the 50% (21 people) of people 12 of them had chosen the 5hr+ box. While people are on screens they are mainly on social medias, play games, listening to music and watching YouTube. These were the divided categories as these questions were open ended. Our last question was what time people get on screens the data ranged from 1am to 9pm, the most used answer is 8:30 am which is when school starts.

Conclusion

- Almost half of the people who did the survey said they spend 5hrs+ on screens every day
- The average person who took the survey spends approximately 3.5hrs on screens every day
- Half of the people who did the survey said they feel good about their screen time usage
- 17 people use screens for school and 16 use it for gaming. 11 use it for socializing and 2 use it for music
